R.E – To the Ends of the Earth The children will learn about the events after Jesus rose again including the Resurrection the Ascension and Pentecost. They will reflect on how the disciples were inspired to share the Good News and what this means for us today.

English – Pattan's Pumpkin by Chitra Soundar This beautiful story will inspire writing linked to resilience kindness and community. Children will write narratives descriptive pieces and instructions leading to a final extended piece.

Maths – Fractions We will explore recognising finding and comparing fractions. The children will learn how to find halves quarters and thirds and apply this knowledge to solve problems.

Science – Plants The children will learn about what plants need to grow and stay healthy. They will observe how plants change over time and explore the different parts of a plant and their functions.
